

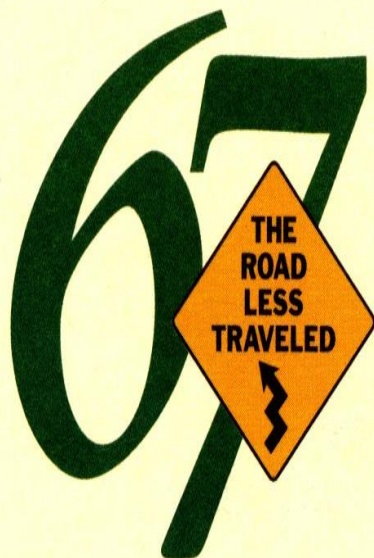

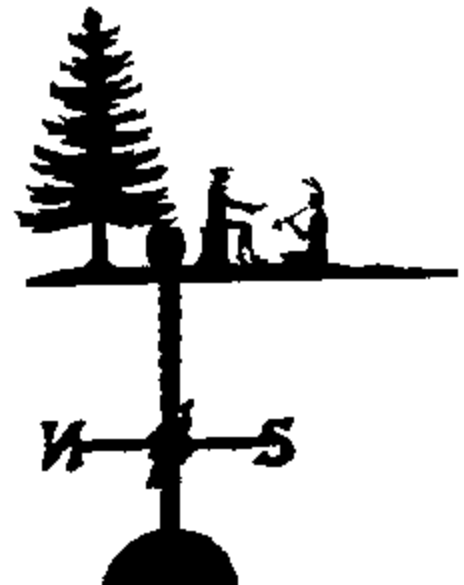

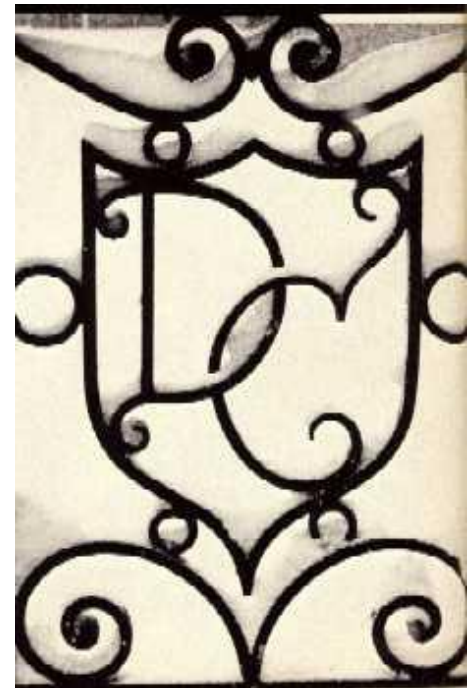

civil rights activist



Melvin died in Washington D.C. in 1987 of AIDS. He spent three years in Brazil with the Peace Corps before completing graduate studies at Oberlin College and Yale University. At the 1980 Democratic Convention, Mel gave a moving address on the effects of discrimination when his name was placed in nomination for vice president. He was a national leader of groups seeking to guarantee the civil rights of blacks and homosexuals, having served as Washington director of the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force and on the 1984 steering committee for Jesse Jackson's presidential campaign.

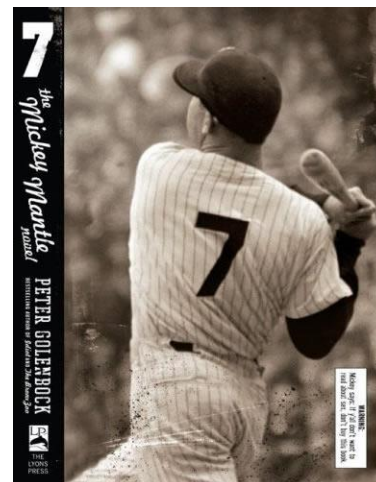
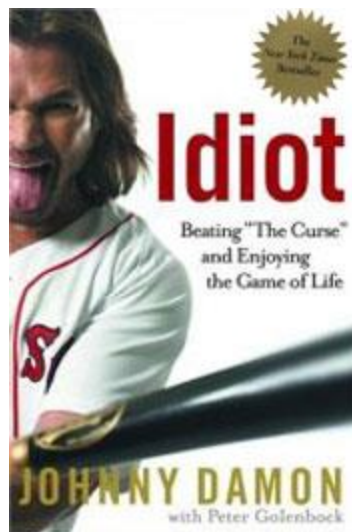
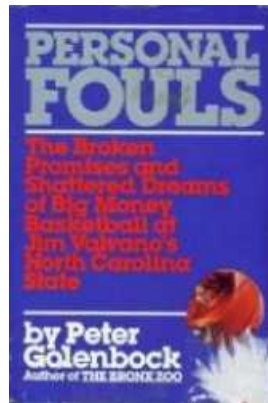
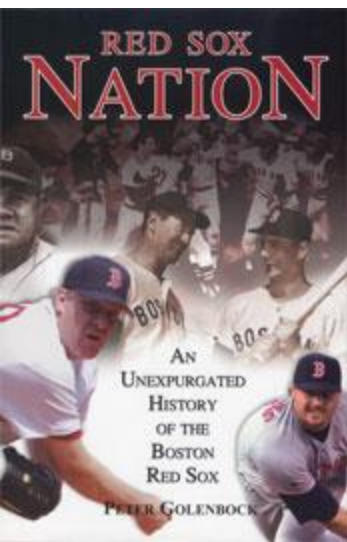
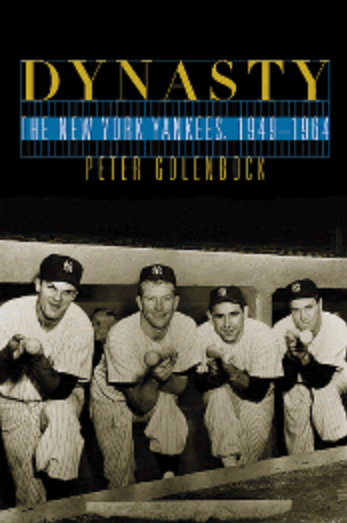
Edward F. “Ned” Gillette
